

Rules for Sherwood Park Tennis and Pickle Ball Courts

- For use by Sherwood Owners, Residents, and their Guests.
- 3 Guests maximum allowed per participating Owner or Resident.
- Courts are open daily from 8:00 AM to dusk.
- No reservations are required. Courts are first come first serve only.
- Play at your own risk. Sherwood Park assumes no liability for injuries or illness.
- Players 12 years old or younger must be accompanied by an adult.
- Proper attire and court shoes required on Courts at all times.
- Water only allowed on Courts.
- No glass containers allowed on Courts.
- No food or gum allowed on Courts.
- No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, scooters, or motorized toys on Courts.
- No animals allowed on Courts.
- No furniture allowed on Courts.
- Trash to be placed in proper receptacles upon completion of play.
- Yield Courts after game or match if other players are waiting.
- Adherence to Tennis and Pickleball Rules and Etiquette of Play is expected.

Guest Definition and Limits:

- Guests are defined as those individuals invited by participating Owners and Residents.
- All Guests are subject to and must adhere to Court Rules.
- Limit of 1 to 3 guests per participating Owner or Resident to allow singles or doubles play.

Pickleball Courts:

- There are four dedicated Pickleball Courts
- The courts are open daily for play to all Owners, Residents, and their Guests.
- After game completion and if all courts are occupied, allow for player or court rotation if other Owners, Residents, and/or their Guests are waiting to play.
- Subject to Court Rules

- Adherence to general Pickleball rules and etiquette of play is expected.

Shared Tennis and Pickleball Court:

- The Court is lined for one tennis court and two Pickleball Courts.
- The Court is open daily with priority for Tennis play by all Owners, Residents, and their Guests.
- Tennis matches are subject to a 90-minute time limit if other Owners, Residents, and their Guests are waiting to play.
- If available, Tennis Court can be used for Pickleball overflow with setup of temporary nets.
- Temporary nets will be properly removed and stored after conclusion of play.
- Upon tennis player request for court use, Pickleball will be discontinued at the conclusion of the current game and temporary nets will be promptly and properly removed.
- Subject to Court Rules
- Adherence to general Tennis and Pickleball rules and etiquette of play is expected.

These Rules were developed by the Sherwood Park Recreational Rules Committee. The Sherwood Park Master Association Board of Directors voted to adopt the proceeding Rules at the July 14, 2020 meeting.
